- Do not over tighten cap to get PERRIN logo to line up with car. If logo doesn't line up please call tech support.
- If your OEM oil cap O-ring is cracked or damaged, replace with new o-ring available from dealer.

## **Installation Procedures**

- 1. Locate and unscrew OEM oil fill cap located on left side of engine.
- 2. Locate and remove rubber gasket/o-ring from cap. NOTE: Use a small pick or tool that will not damage o-ring.
- 3. Install OEM o-ring into PERRIN oil fill cap and reinstall back onto engine.
- 4. Cap is designed such that the PERRIN logo will be lined up with front of car if installed correctly. Overtightening cap one time may help o-ring seat into groove and allow logo to line up better. If logo does not line up after doing this a couple of times, remove OEM O-ring and install supplied O-ring into groove. Then follow one of two options below.
  - a. Install OEM o-ring so the flat side touches the new included o-ring. Then retest alignment.
  - b. Install OEM o-ring so the rounded/tapered side side touches the new included o-ring. Then retest alignment.
